Part 1: Participation in LHS Performing Ensembles / Classes

Students must be at least junior standing AND have participated in 6 semesters of music (could be a combination of music classes). Students are eligible for ensemble pin (i.e. "CHOIR", "JAZZ", "ORCH", "BAND", "GUARD") after 6 semesters in a specific group. General Music Classes: Vocal Links, IB Music, Music Technology, Guitar, Piano, LHS Mariachis, World Music Drumming

Part 2: Additional Criteria Need 1 per semester with at least 4 different categories (of the 8 total) represented.

- Non LHS Concert (High School or more advanced) Attendance or Performance
- Participation in Solo / Small Ensemble Contest (February)
- Audition & Participation in Honor Ensemble
- Music Leadership

- Music Report / Project / Composition (designed by student)
- Private Music Lessons
- Participation in Music Camp
