## Schoo Behavior Matrix: Bathroom

Characters: Josie, Harper, Ruby, Stedman, Narrator

Narrator: The scene begins outside the girls' restroom between classes. Josie, Harper and Ruby are walking into the restroom together. Josie notices Stedman standing at the drinking fountain getting a drink.

Josie: Harper! Ruby! Let's play a joke on Stedman and pull him into the restroom with us.
