Workshop Goals:

- Help students become efficient, effective, confident testtakers for the ACT, PSAT, and SAT tests.
- Review test content and learn testing strategies.
- Provide outstanding, affordable test prep for *all* students including private and home-schooled students.

What you should not expect from the workshop:

- A prep workshop CANNOT substitute for good academic preparation. A student should take college prep classes or the most challenging courses he or she can handle, and READ, READ, READ to improve reading speed and comprehension.
- A prep workshop CANNOT guarantee test scores that ensure scholarships or college admission. LPS workshops provide an excellent opportunity to prepare, but score improvement depends mostly on a student's time and energy investment.
- Cost: \$125 per workshop
 - Tuition is reduced if a student qualifies for free or reduced lunch. Verification of lunch status required: a copy of the approval letter or an email from your school counselor. Email <u>MFONCK@LPS.ORG</u> or contact your school counselor for tuition information.

Refund Policy: Cancellation requests must be received before the first class date. A \$20.00 handling fee will apply.

Late Registration Fee: \$20 (if not registered by the deadline)

Late Fee For Unpaid Registrations: The \$20 late fee also applies to registrants who have not paid the tuition by the "pay by" date. If a workshop is full, unpaid registrants may lose their spot in the workshop to paid registrants on the waiting list.

Questions about which test to take, when to take these tests, and how to register for the tests: Please contact your student's school counselor for up-to-date college information. We focus on test prep methods only.

Are there other ways to prepare for these tests? Absolutely! A student can take the practice test in the registration booklet or online at the ACT and SAT websites; or study independently with prep books available at bookstores. An internet search will offer other local and online options.

Students with IEPs may qualify for adjusted testing conditions for a live test. Contact your IEP manager to apply. Your IEP manager must submit documentation used by ACT or SAT to determine the type and extent of adjustments allowed.

Please talk to your student before registering!

An evening course after a school day tests a student's endurance. Be sure your student is committed to investing the time and energy needed, and is aware of the workshop rules:

- Attendance will be taken each week.
- No cell phones during class.
- We will contact parents if students disrupt class and for unexcused absences.

OPTIONAL ACT WRITING TEST – **National ACT test only:** If a college requires the writing test, your student must register & pay for this optional test when registering for the ACT test.

SAT NATIONAL TEST DATES - Register at <u>http://www.collegeboard.com/</u>or by mail using a registration booklet from your school's counseling office.

PSAT TEST DATE: Oct. 19: *To be considered for National Merit Scholarships, a junior must take the PSAT. Students MUST register through the schools' counseling offices; no online registration is available.*
