Schoo Behavior Matrix: Hallways

Characters: Narrator, Huy, Sam, Pat, Sydney, Hatem

Narrator—The setting for this scene is the main hallway returning to class from lunch. Students are talking to each other walking toward their lockers. We see Huy, Sam and Sydney visiting with each other as they go to Huy's locker.

Huy: Hey, let's stop at my locker and kill some time before we have to go to class. I have a pack of gum I will share with you.

Sam: That's a good idea! I would love a piece of gum.

Sydney: I can stop for a few seconds but I don't want to be late to my next class. I hate filling out those pink slips if I am tardy!

Sam: Syd, don't be such a downer! Who cares if we are late?
