








## Basic Behavior Strategies

Strategy	Examples
 <b>Actively Supervise</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be present and watching</li> <li>• Engage with children</li> <li>• Acknowledge appropriate behavior</li> </ul>
 <b>Pre-Correct</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prompt expected behavior prior to situations</li> <li>• Remind them of the desired behavior</li> <li>• Acknowledge appropriate behavior</li> </ul>
 <b>Active Engagement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check on children frequently</li> <li>• Teach social skills, play skills</li> <li>• Acknowledge appropriate behavior</li> </ul>
 <b>Acknowledge Expected Behavior</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Give at least 4 positive statements for every corrective statement</li> <li>• Acknowledge specific appropriate behaviors</li> <li>• Respond immediately</li> </ul>

# Strategies for Getting Involved with Supporting Your Child At School

Strategy	Examples
 <p><b>Talk About School at Home</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask your child about his/her day               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Be specific: What is one thing they learned or did well?</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Talk about what is being discussed in classes</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Praise Efforts and Progress</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognize when he/she is trying</li> <li>• Notice improvements</li> <li>•</li> </ul>
 <p><b>Establish a Homework Routine</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Establish a consistent time and place</li> <li>• Supervise actively and positively</li> <li>• Acknowledge effort frequently</li> </ul>



### **Talk with Your Child's Teacher**

- Share strengths with the teacher
- Suggest things that are helpful for your child
- Praise efforts of the teacher



### **Teach and Acknowledge School- Wide Expectations**

- Discuss the school-wide expectations
- Discuss examples of the expectations
- Acknowledge when the student follows these expectations at home
