ACTIVE SUPERVISION



WHAT IS ACTIVE SUPERVISION?

Moving continuously, scanning all areas of the classroom and interacting positively, frequently and authentically.



Increases student engagement and appropriate behavior



Quick assistance to students





Can frequently use positive feedback



Move: Continuous Movement



Scan: Visually sweep/see all areas and students





Interact: Proximity, provide frequent prompts and feedback



Use data: Be proactive





All types of instruction

Transitioning students: hallways, before school, after school



SUMMARY



Move continuously, Scan all interactions and areas, Interact positively, frequently and authentically

Research affirms the introduction of active supervision produced a classroom-wide decrease in minor behavioral incidents. (Simonsen, Fairbanks, Briesch, Myers, & Sugai, 2008)
