

DEVELOPING CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS



WHAT ARE CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS?

Positively stated classroom rules that are consistent with school wide expectations and are explicitly taught using posters and lesson plans.



WHY DEVELOP AND TEACH EXPECTATIONS?

Students know exactly what to do

Ensures all students have learned the necessary skills to meet expectations.



TEACH: Using posted expectations

PRACTICE: Using a quick activity that models a positive example



REINFORCE: Using specific positive feedback



GENERALIZE: By planning to review expectations and using pre-corrects

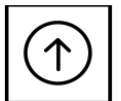


HOW TO TEACH EXPECTATIONS?



WHEN TO TEACH EXPECTATIONS?

Any time you need to increase the likelihood that students will be successful.



Use Data: Identify patterns and what expectation needs reteaching.



SUMMARY



Teach students how to meet expectations

Teach, practice, reinforce, and generalize the behavioral/social skills

Research affirms that pairing rule instruction with feedback and reinforcement leads to the largest gains. (Simonsen, Fairbanks, Briesch, Myers, & Sugai, 2008)
