

The Career Academy is a joint venture between Lincoln Public Schools and Southeast Community College. The goal of TCA is to provide academic and real world experiences to high school students through high school and dual credit courses in 16 different career pathways.

Juniors and seniors attend TCA for two hours a day during the school year while taking their remaining courses back at their home high school. Transportation in the LPS district is provided, books are free, and tuition is through scholarships or paid at a 50% discount to the regular SCC credit hour charge.
